BMW Roadriders, American National announce scholarships for Motorcycle Basic Rider Course

Springfield, MO – Students planning to take a Basic Rider Course (BRC) at Ozarks Technical College (OTC) through November are eligible for the last of this year’s scholarships that are still available through the Springfield BMW Roadriders and insurance provider, American National.

The fee for the BRC course is \$200 per student. This year, registrants completing the course can benefit with financial support through \$50 scholarships from American National and the Springfield BMW Roadriders. The two organizations set aside funding for 16 scholarships that would be given this year on a first-come, first-served basis. Several of the scholarships are still available.

“We are proud to support motorcyclists’ dedication to safety,” said Madelynn Innes, national market coordinator for American National’s AmeriCycle[®] motorcycle insurance. “In addition to the course scholarship, we also provide a Safe Rider discount as part of our motorcycle insurance policy to all who complete the Basic Rider Course.”

The BRC course is a partnership among Traffic Safety Alliance of the Ozarks (TSA), OTC, and American National. Registration is administered through OTC. The course is offered at MODOT Riding Range and the Price Cutter Park (PCP).
